The Rotary Club of Corowa is pleased to offer Corowa students the opportunity to apply for the Fred Taylor Memorial Scholarship of \$3,000.

The scholarship is open to students who were resident in Corowa whilst studying their HSC and are now undertaking tertiary studies at a University, or TAFE College, irrespective of what year they are undertaking.

Students will be evaluated on their academic performance and their contribution to the local community, either through their schools or extracurricular activities.

To apply for the Fred Taylor Memorial Scholarship, please complete the attached form and ensure that you are able to comply with the following conditions:

- You must already be enrolled and have commenced, or are about to commence, study at a tertiary institution.
- The course must be full time study.
- You are prepared to be interviewed by a panel (by phone, video conference or face to face), as to your suitability for the scholarship.
- Provide a copy of your academic record with your application.
- Attach academic recommendations as to you your suitability for this award, e.g. Principal, Dean, Head of School or Supervisor.
- Be prepared to visit the Rotary Club of Corowa from time to time to give the club a short presentation on your academic progress and life on campus.

Applications open March 1st and close Friday the 12th of April 2024. Applicants will be interviewed by a panel appointed by the club and at a time suitable to all.

The scholarship will only be awarded to a recipient once.
