Glenys Attkins and Katrina Pawley Albury Wodonga Regional Foodshare

They are located in Wodonga but service a 150km radius. Foodshare are a group that helps people with financial hardship or are poverty stricken. They are a conduit for different Agencies to get food to people in need.

They warehouse food for groups to pick up and distribute. They do deliver to some groups. They help reduce food waste and increase food nutrition to people.

Foodshare have 45 suppliers and they buy some food from the Victorian Food Bank. Stores like Woolworths, Coles, Aldi, Uncle Toby's and local farmers also donate/supply food on a regular basis to the warehouse. At the warehouse over 100 volunteers take turns helping to quality control the food and pack it for groups. 200 Agencies come and collect food from the warehouse or it is delivered to others.

In the region there is over 24,000 people in poverty, 5,000 are children. Foodshare distributes over 763,000 kgs of food, fresh and packaged, to many of these people. They are a vital link to the community and agencies that help those in need.

Foodshare are funded by many corporate sponsors, grants and other service clubs like Rotary. They also raise over \$100,000 a year through fundraising.

The issue they have now is Foodshare, need to move from their current place to a new one soon.

They are also looking to expand/build a new 800m2 building in the next few years.

Until that time they are asking if anyone knows a place that can move to before January 2020.

The value of Foodshare is that for every \$1 it equals \$40 worth of food. \$40 worth of food equals 10 meals.

A little can go a long way.




