





International Toast: The Rotary Club of Sydney Cove. District 9675 The Coves began as an official club on the 23 June 1988. They are a diverse group with a common goal of giving back to the community they live and work in. District 9675 is one of Sydney's largest rotary clubs with over 100 members. They meet each week on a Friday morning from 7.15 to 8.30am, aboard a Captain Cook Cruise Vessel, moored at Eastern Pontoon on the board walk to the opera house, Circular Quay Sydney. Their meetings cost \$35.00. They always have a guest speaker. The Coves are involved in over 30 community projects. Every year in November they hold one large charity fund raiser. This is the Rotary Solas Regatta in conjunction with the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia. Back in 1996 saw them raise \$75,000.00 which they donated to the Children's West Mead Hospital. A four bed ward was named in their honour. The Rotary Club of Sydney Cove Ward. Two nights per month they man the Vinnies night patrol food service, they work with the early bird café which provides food for the homeless as well as hosting a Christmas party at the King George V centre for the homeless street soccer. They provide drought relief and support the Mardi Gras. They also marshal City 2 Surf, plus the coves support The Stand Tall initiative founded by their own member Nick Farr-Jones to support Youth at Risk. Their Inter National service is the Timor Leste Sanitation Project, where they are going to build toilets and bathrooms for remote schools A little bit of useful Trivia that will help you all sleep better tonight!!!! Is in August 1989 the first Female member was inducted. They suspect that this may well beaten the Rotary International decision to allow lady members and made the club the first to do so in Australia and perhaps the first in the Rotary world. In 1990 the first Honorary member was inducted being no Other than His Excellency Rear Admiral Peter Sinclair AO Governor of NSW.


