

International Toast : The Rotary Club of Yellowknife, Canada

- 1) Yellowknife is a community next the great Slave Lake in southern part of the North West Territories of Canada.
- 2) Yellowknife is the capital and only city, as well as the largest community, in the Northwest Territories, Canada. It is located on the northern shore of Great Slave Lake, approximately 400 km south of the Arctic Circle, on the west side of Yellowknife Bay near the outlet of the Yellowknife River
- 3) In the 2021 Canadian census, Yellowknife recorded a population of 20,340
- 4) It is very isolated. There is only one road in to Yellowknife. They do have an airport which most people use.
- 5) They do have two Rotary Clubs - The Rotary Club of Yellowknife which was sponsored by the West Edmonton Rotary Club on May 23, 1970 and the Rotary Club of Yellowknife True North.
- 6) I am looking at the Rotary Club of Yellowknife.
- 7) Their current president is Celestino Oh
- 8) The Rotary Club of Yellowknife numbers 70 men and women of all ages
- 9) They meet on Thursdays at 12:00 PM Explorer Hotel, Yellowknife, NT, Canada
- 10) During the summer, they transfer their meetings to Rotary Park. In the event of rain in the forecast we may move indoors to the local Anglican Church Basement.
- 11) The Rotary Club of Yellowknife has donated \$5,000 to United Way NWT to assist flood victims in Hay River and Kátł'odeeche First Nation, who are currently under evacuation orders.
- 12) It's through the generous support of Rotary activities by the Yellowknife community that has allowed the YK Club to make the donation to the victims of river ice breakup flooding in the South Slave region.
- 13) The Rotary Club of Yellowknife is organizing a colorful Community Parade to communicate Canada Day. This is the first time they have been able this parade since 2019 and it will be preceded for the first time by a foot race featuring local runners.
- 14) The Rotary Club of Yellowknife has joined millions of people across the globe by making a humanitarian donation to the people of Ukraine, who have been caught up in the Russian invasion. The Yellowknife Club has authorized a donation of \$4,000 to be made to the Ukraine Humanitarian Crisis Appeal of the Canadian Red Cross.
- 15) The Club has sent many students from the NWT to live and study in other countries for a full year under the Youth Exchange Program. Students from the NWT who have participated.

Rotarians: 1,204,997* in 36,945 clubs in 545 Districts in 220 countries/geographic areas.


Rotaractors: 234,520* in 11,150 clubs in 532 districts in 184 countries/geographic areas.

Australian and New Zealand districts include Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, Timor Leste, American Samoa, Cook Islands, Fiji, French Polynesia, Kiribati, New Caledonia, Norfolk Island, Samoa, Tonga and Vanuatu, where there are 606 Rotarians in 41 clubs.

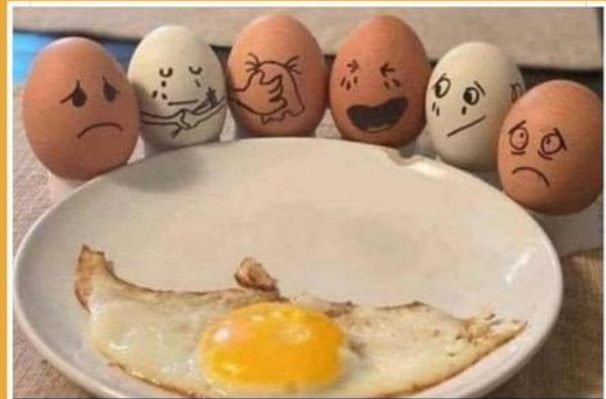

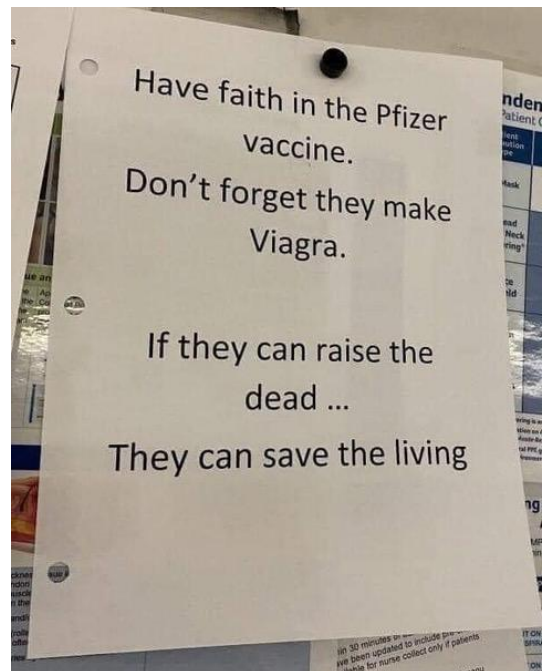
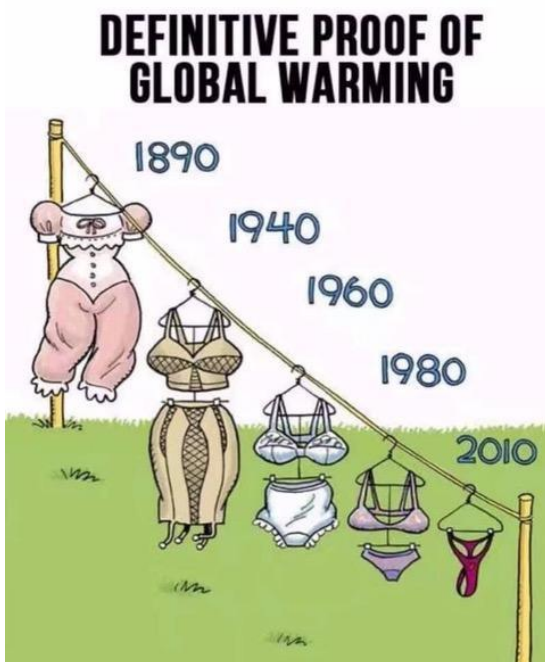
