Jones is founder and president of Media Street Productions Inc., an award-winning media company in Windsor. She was chair of the board of governors of the University of Windsor and chair of the Windsor-Essex Regional Chamber of Commerce. She has been recognized for her service with the YMCA Peace Medallion, the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal, and Wayne State University's Peacemaker of the Year Award, a first for a Canadian. Jones holds a Doctor of Laws (LL.D.).

As the first woman to be elected president, Jones understands how important it is to follow through on Rotary's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Statement. "I believe that diversity, equity, and inclusion ... begins at the top and for us to realize growth in female membership and members under the age of forty — these demographics need to see their own reflection in leadership," Jones said. "I will champion double-digit growth in both categories while never losing sight of our entire family."

Jones has been a Rotary member since 1997 and has served Rotary as RI vice president, director, training leader, committee chair, moderator, and district governor. She played a lead role in Rotary's rebranding effort by serving as chair of the Strengthening Rotary Advisory Group. She is the co-chair of the End Polio Now Countdown to History Campaign Committee, which aims to raise \$150 million for polio eradication efforts. She also led the successful telethon in 2020, which raised critical funds for COVID-19 relief and was viewed by more than 65,000 people.

Jones has also received Rotary International's Service Above Self Award and The Rotary Foundation Citation for Meritorious Service. She and her husband, Nick Krayacich, are members of The Rotary Foundation's Arch Klumph Society, Paul Harris Society, and the Bequest Society.

## Guest Speakers- Jenny Jensen & Cristy Jacka

Cbag & C Plan Update for Corowa and their community.

After listening to Cristy & Jenny last year at a Rotary meeting we decided as a club to make a commitment to the Cbag & C Plan Project we have purchased 25 packs and have given them to the Corowa Medical Centre to offer to patients that will benefit from the packs.

The Corowa Free Press will feature an article next week about Rotary and the C packs depending on the response from the community we will hopefully be able to commit to this project on a more regular basis.

The Cbag and Cplan are an amazing supportive care package put together by a sub-committee of the AWCF to help support patients on a diagnosis with cancer.

The Cbag is the concept of Jenny Jensen and the cPlan is the concept of Cristy Jacka.

Cancer survivor Christy McIntosh helped form the name 'cBAG' (A care bag for people with cancer), and reflected on her personal experience.

The cBag is modelled from the Breast Cancer support bag that is given to Breast Cancer patients to help them through their journey. The cBAG is designed to be a practical 'showbag' for patients with cancer. It includes items such as mints to disguise bad tastes, odour eliminator, hand warmers and fluffy socks for warmth, an information magnet for numbers needed in a hurry, coloured pencils for mindfulness drawing, a book of inspiring local stories and a carved wooden item to hold for comfort.

Cristy Jacka lost her husband in 2017 and she wanted everyone to have a 'wedding planner' for cancer. Somewhere that everyone could keep the important information and records that became part of your life when diagnosed with cancer. And so the cPLAN was born. The cPLAN is also part of the care package.

The first production in 2020 of 1500 cBAGs has been made possible by support from the Bendigo Bank and \$20,000 from the Albury Wodonga Regional Cancer Centre Trust Fund.
