### **World Environment Day Handbook**

At a previous week's meeting I picked up – at President Deb's invitation – a Handbook for Rotary Clubs on World Environment Day, which is celebrated on 5th June each year.

The handbook had been developed by the Environmental Sustainability Rotarian Action Group (ESRAG – another Rotary acronym!)

'Supporting the Environment' is now R.I.'s 7th area of focus behind

- 1. Promoting Peace
- 2. Fighting Disease
- 3. Providing Clean Water, Sanitation and Hygiene
- 4. Saving Mothers and Children
- 5. Supporting Education
- 6. Growing Local Economies

Remarkably, 'the Environment' can be seen to integrate all 6!

Eleven Green Themes are suggested and action in the form of Rotary Club projects are outlined.

Our Club can relate to a number of them, as we had a foundational interest in the Community Gardens, have adopted a highway section to clean up, and have as a major project the 'Whitehead Street Wetlands'.

Currently President Deb has put together a letter to the schools to invite school communities to participate in the collection of bread tags – *Aussie Bread Tags project* – which when re-cycled will provide money for wheelchairs for overseas disabled people.
