ATTENDANCE: 11 Members out of 22 (50%)

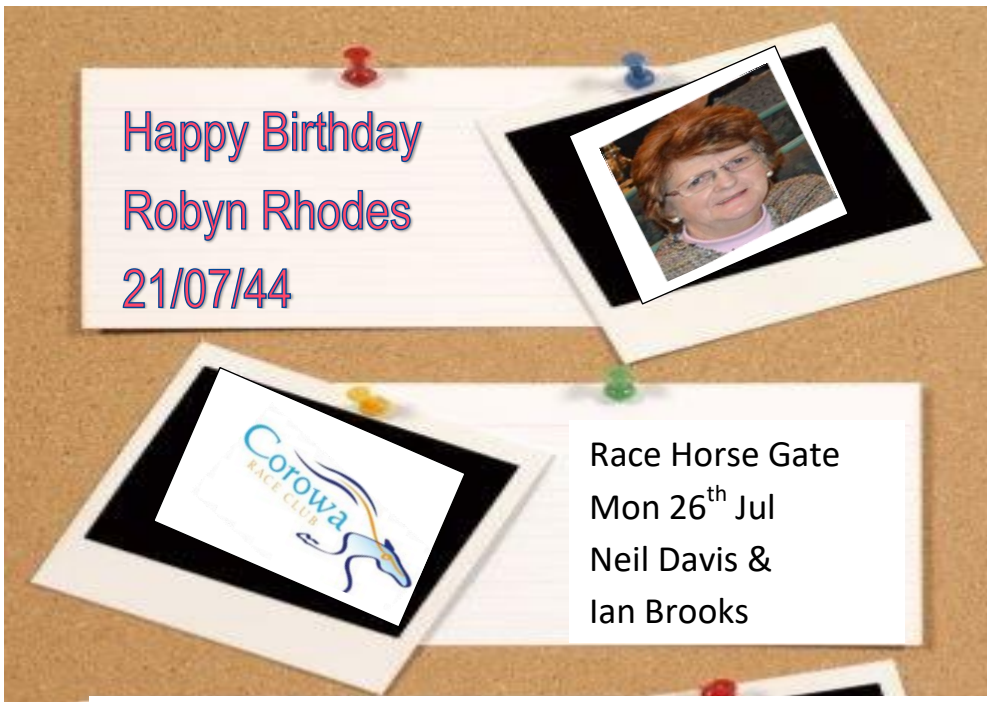
