Born in Mildura to parents who were both teachers. Eldest of 4, 2 brothers and a sister. Spent most of my early years living at 15th street Irymple. Moved to Melbourne in 1969.

Started uni in 74 but after 4 years of very disciplined boys school, I let loose. 2 years later we both agreed I should leave and try something new. I joined up with a mate and we went into the bluestone business. 1000 stone a day hand loaded into an old Atkinson tandem tipper with a Detroit 2 stroke diesel. A couple of years later my body decided it had had enough and I packed up and went travelling through England and Europe for a couple of years. I returned home broke and decided I needed to go back to uni where I spent the next 6 years. I met Dee, a few months before graduating – I knew she wasn't after me for my money because I didn't have any, and we have been together ever since. We married in 87, built a house in Rowville and had a daughter Nicole. My first job out of uni was as a training officer for the SEC in the Latrobe valley. Then onto PACCAR (Kenworth Trucks) as Training and Development Manager. But Paccar wouldn't provide a company car so I went to Carton and United Breweries as training and development manager, looking after half of Australia. But the culture was terrible and after 12 months I made it known I was looking for a change and Paccar enticed me back with a package that included a car! I was with Paccar for nine years, ending up retail operations manager. But I was looking for a change, and went to McKay Australia as sales and marketing manager of their.....

commercial wheel division which had just been purchased by a Malaysian multi national – HICOM (Heavy Industry Corporation of Malaysia). It was an amazing period with Asia going gang busters and the transfer of

manufacturing technology to Malaysia. But the Malaysians didn't appreciate good industrial practice with its workforce and

after 2 years of very questionable decisions I resigned.

I started with Repco as sales and marketing manager of their wholesale division. Repco at this point in time was part of Pacific Dunlop and boy were the next 7 years going to be a ride with company ownership changes and buyouts.



Around 2002 we made a decision that well and truly changed our lives. We purchased a 100+ year old log cabin Irish tavern and restaurant at Olinda in the

Dandenong Ranges. For the next 7 years we lived in a house behind the restaurant and Dee managed it. We knew nothing about running a restaurant and it was one hell of a learning curve. Now that really was one hell of a ride.

In the mean time, I was the GM of a marketing agency whose clients included a number of car companies and we began specialising in the digital arena. We sold the restaurant and I started my own it marketing agency in 2010 with just a handful of clients and an idea for a unique i.t. communication platform. We created the Meridan platform and leased that platform to:

- Renault Australia, Asia Pacific, Africa, India and the Middle East
- Mitsubishi Australia
- Nissan Australia, NZ and Asia Pacific

We sold the company in 2021 and retired.
