

A great weekend was had by all, the outbound and inbound students were able to spend time getting to know each other along with DG David McPherson, The Youth Exchange Committee, Rotex, Parents, Host Parents, Student Counselors and Rotarians. A lot of information was shared to inform and guide the students and their families.

MESSAGE FROM MEREDITH FOR YOUTH EXCHANGE HOST FAMILIES

Thank you for offering to host Andrej or the exchange students we will host next year.

As discussed at our recent meeting, simply having a Working with Children Check is not sufficient for any person who has direct contact (possibly one on one) with a youth involved in any Rotary Youth Program. For those wishing to complete their volunteer registration and Host Family application now, please find below the information and links you require. There is no rush to do this (some won't host for another year yet) but it does need to be done before hosting. If you are not hosting but think you may take Andrej or future students away with you, you should complete just the volunteer registration.

When hosting and exchange student, all adult members of Host Families are required to complete a Youth Volunteer Program Application, provide referees and be interviewed, in addition to having a current WWCC. When completing your registration online, you will nominate referees, and this will fulfil the requirements. The referees nominated online are sent a link to fill out a short online questionnaire (8 questions of which 4 are Yes/No). It doesn't take them long to complete the form.

Please use the following link to begin your registration: https://yehub.net/A79-volapp Click on the link (or copy and paste it into your browser) to get started.

Once you have completed the registration you will be asked to forward your WWCC details for verification, in most cases we already have your WWCC on file, so please ignore this automated message. Your Volunteer Registration will be valid until your WWCC expires; at which time it will need to be renewed.

All adult volunteers must also complete training which focuses on Youth Protection. The four units required for Youth Exchange Volunteers are Youth Protection Awareness, Culture Shock and Reverse Culture Shock, Counsellor Training and Volunteer Training. You will be enrolled in these once you have completed your Volunteer Registration. The courses are linked to YEAH which is a US based program so there are some ideocracies for which we apologise in advance! It is not practical for us to develop our own modules and by using the modules within the database we are able to show that we are adhering to Rotary International and Australian state education requirements. D9790 takes youth protection, abuse and harassment very seriously and, whilst no amount of policies and screening can eliminate the possibility of it occurring, by having a rigorous process in place we are doing our best to ensure that our participants are safe.

The Host Family Application can be accessed via the link: https://yehub.net/A79-hfapp. If host families wish to add photos, they can do this during the application process. All adult members of the Host Family also need to complete a Volunteer Registration as above. The same referees can be used for both applications.


