## PARADE INFORMATION

Date: Sunday 28th January 2024

<u>Time</u>: Participants must be assembled by 9.00 am for the commencement of the parade at 10.00 am

Assembly Point: TBA

<u>Parade Location</u>: Sanger Street Corowa (commencing at the corner of Sanger and Isabel Streets)

<u>Parade Exit</u>: Floats are to disperse at the roundabout to the right into Edward Street. All other participants are to disperse at the roundabout to the left into Edward Street.

## PARADE RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. All vehicles must be registered and insured. If vehicles are not registered, an Unregistered Vehicle Permit is required to enable participation. Evidence of insurance must be provided prior to participation.
- 2. Evidence of public liability insurance covering participation in the parade must be provided prior to participation.
- 3. Vehicles must not exceed 10 km/hr and must at all times maintain separation distance of 5 metres from the vehicle in front. All vehicles must be driven by an adult who holds a current and relevant licence.
- 4. Participants must obey all instructions/directions from parade marshals.
- 5. No objects (e.g., lollies) are to be thrown from parade floats unless prior written approval is given by the parade organisers. If such approval is required, please note this on page one in the float description.
- 6. Where possible, parade participants are to keep to the centre of the road.
- 7. All details for proposed activities during the parade must be noted on the entry form, to ensure that these activities are approved by the parade organisers.
- 8. Animals are not permitted in this parade, unless prior written approval is given by the parade organisers. If such approval is required, please note this on page one in the float description.
- 9. Participants must not entice or encourage spectators onto the roadway.
- 10. **Precautions** must be taken to ensure the safety of those being transported on vehicles. This is the responsibility of the business/organisation coordinating the float.
- 11. Participants must not get on or off a float while it is moving.
- 12. Participants are always to remain aware of spectators, particularly as spectators begin to migrate towards Bangerang Park.
- 13. Photographs taken of the parade, including parade participants, may be used for media and promotional purposes.
- 14. Parade organisers reserve the right to cancel the parade at any time due to weather conditions.

The organisation I represent and/or I agree to the rules and conditions associated with entering the Federation Festival Parade. I accept all responsibility and fully understand the risks associated with this event and I have conveyed this to those involved in my float/activity. I will always implement controls to ensure the safety of those involved in my float/activities.
