It was an informative presentation and we thank Stephen for speaking to us.



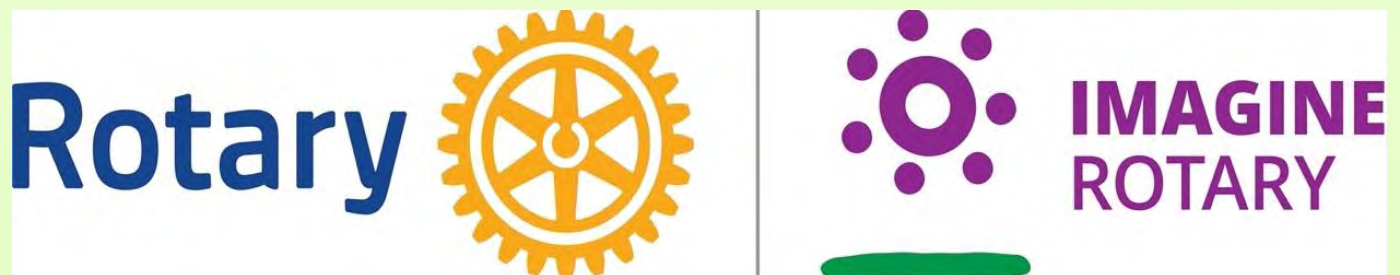

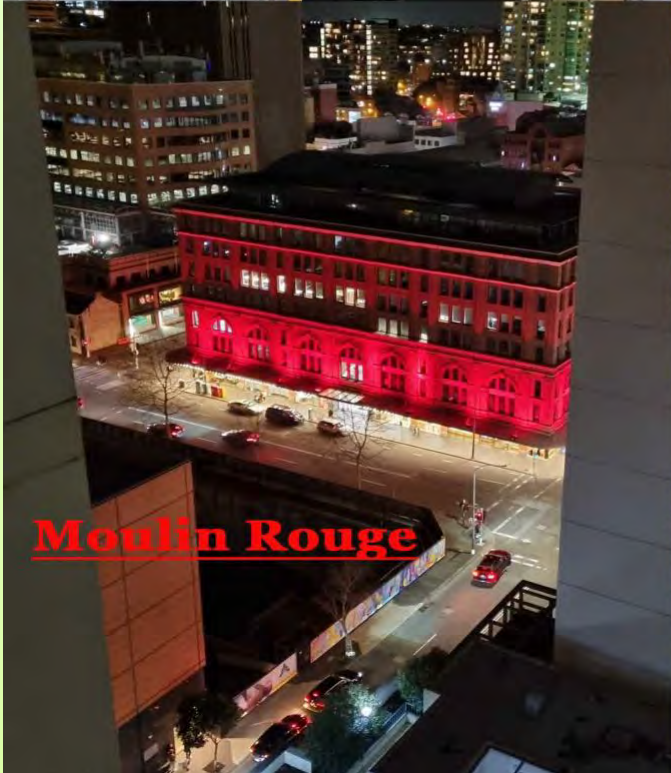
