Barry showed the End Polio Now video. It gave everyone all the information they needed to understand the program.

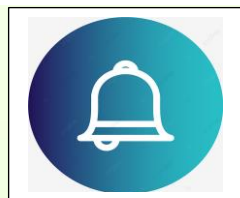
Barry did a brief intro and let the video speak for itself. Neil briefly spoke about the trip he did with Rotary to India a few years ago to help with polio vaccinations.

## International Toast - Rotary Club of Poprad, Slovakia.

Andrej's home town of Smizany's, the closest Rotary Club is the 23 km away.

The Rotary Club of Poprad was chartered in May 1935 and at that time was part of Czechoslovakia.

As WW2 approached and the advent of the Fascist State, Rotary was banned and with the Russian Communist Regime after WW2, the ban continued. Early 1990's the Czech Republic and the Slovak Republic were established.

In May 1997 – 62 years after its original beginning the Rotary Club of Poprad again received a Rotary International Charter.

They currently have 17 members and in recent years have fundraised for donations of adjustable chairs, beds and wheelchairs for Poprad Red Cross House, specialised physio service for disabled children and 2 infusion pumps for the Oncology Department at Poprad Hospital.

We are recognising them for their role in Youth Exchange bringing Andrej to our Club.

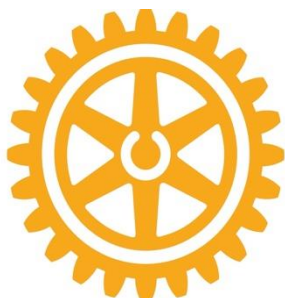
