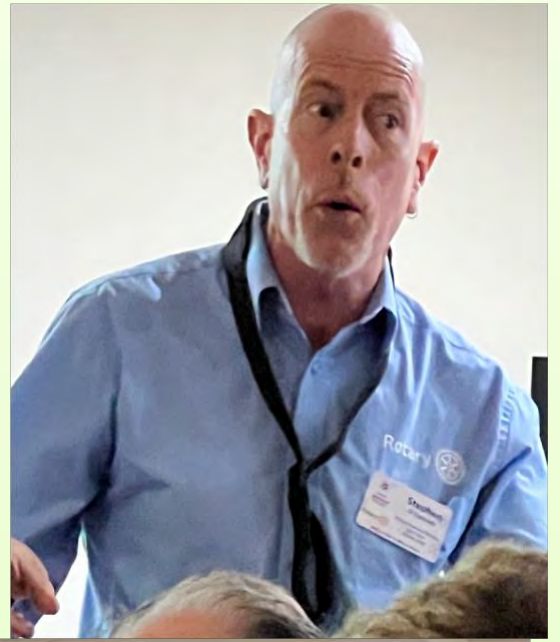

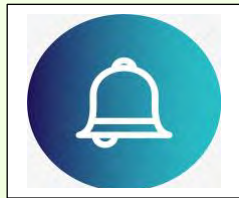




This is a typical scene of my studio environment when I write music
