

Thank you for your donation of £525 to Aquabox, from the Club.

This kind donation will allow us to send 2 community filters and a family filter when we next respond to a disaster across the world. These filters will provide water for up to 1000 people.

The past 12 months have proved to be a very busy year for <u>Aquabox</u> and thanks to the great generosity of our friends and supporters we were able to respond to a <u>number of</u> natural and man-made disasters across the world. This has included sending aid to the Yemen, Pakistan/ Afghanistan, Puerto Rico, Malawi as well as sending 10 shipments to <u>Ukraine</u>

During the past 3 month a major focus has been responding to Turkey and Syria in the aftermath of the earthquake that has devastated the region. Working with partners in Turkey and Syria, it has been possible to respond to families and communities in both countries. <u>However</u> with the conflict showing no sign of abating in Ukraine we have plans to send a further consignment of aid to the Rotary WASH Hub in Lyiv this summer
