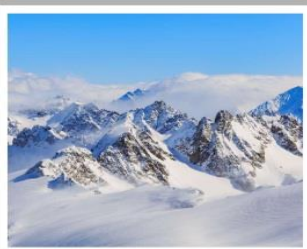

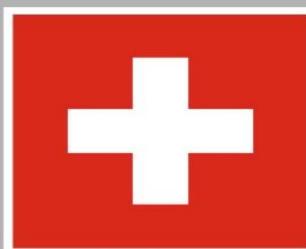

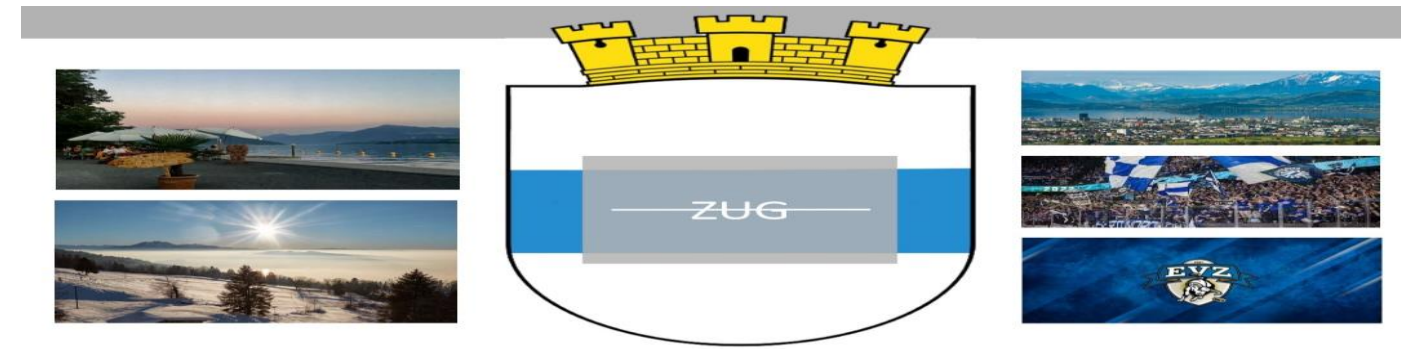

Typical Switzerland

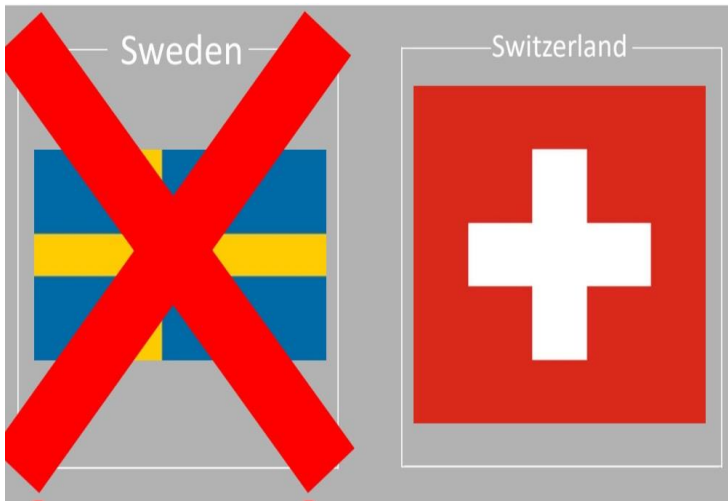
