## **Guest Speaker – Matt Flaherty**

Establishment of Dialysis Centre in Kohalpur and Dhulikhel

Project Summary: Establishing a dialysis centre in Kohalpur and Dhulikhel, Nepal can be a life-changing and sustainable project for the people in the region. Chronic kidney disease is a serious health concern in Nepal, and many people require regular dialysis treatments to manage the condition. However, access to quality dialysis services is limited, especially in rural areas like Kohalpur and also in Urban Areas like Dhulikhel. Rental 11 kidly patient untimely died because they are not able to get routine haemodialysis in Kohalpur.

Project Tentative Cost: \$200,000

Dialysis Machine Required: 15 (5 in Kohalpur and 10 in Dhulikhel)

RO water filter required: 2 units




