The Rotary Club has a significant impact on many events not the least of these the building of the Vancouver Trade and Convention Centre.

For over 40 years the club's hearing foundation has provided life changing care for adults and children with hearing disorders.

From funding Canadas first ever cochlear implant surgery in 1982 to completing over 770 surgeries and committing 6 million dollars to revolutionising patient care.

Helping to raise money the club annually runs a ride for hearing which raised over 3.8 million dollars since it began in 1985.

The club also supports initiatives that create water wells for villagers in Africa.

The club provides leadership and personal development opportunities to youth through rotary support programs. Rotary's youth programs are focused on kids, teenagers and young adults.

The club meets every Tuesday at 12 noon terminal city club.




