Family assistance program provides parents with food and fuel vouchers to ease some of the financial pressures so that they can concentrate on spending their time bonding and caring for their baby.

Now a RAWCS project with aim of raising \$50,000. Each club asked to donate to foundation.

"Say No to Domestic Violence" a second project with functions or walk in early December to raise awareness in community and not be silent.

Yes, to respectful relationships, .Neta concluded by saying Rotary International is worldwide, we are all RI, and without us RI would not exist. We have skills, compassion, engaged in community - we are Rotary International.
