

Sylvia Whitlock became the first female president of a Rotary club when she was elected president of the Duarte Rotary club in 1987

1990 - The first woman President of a club in Australia was Cathy Roth who formed the Rotary Club of Geelong Central and was inducted by the Rotary International President, Royce Abbey, and Australia's third Rotary International President.

1995 - In July, eight women become district governors, the first elected to this role: Mimi Altman, Gilda Chirafisi, Janet W. Holland, Reba F. Lovrien, Virginia B. Nordby, Donna J. Rapp, Anne Robertson, and Olive P. Scott.

1999 - 2000Una Hobday OAM She was also the first female District Governor in the southern hemisphere being elected DG District 9540.

(June 29, 2022) – Jennifer Jones, member of the Rotary Club of Windsor-Roseland, Ontario, Canada, will be the first woman to take office as Rotary International President in the service organization's 117-year existence on 1 July 2022.
