Rotary information- supplied by Graeme Campbell Minutes from directors meeting 16th November 1945

Present President Eric, John Roach, "W.E", Bill Jasper, Herbert Grimond and Harry Evans, honourable secretary.

Apologies Fred Matthews.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read Anne confirmed on the motion of WE & J Roach carried. Correspondence far West Children's Health scheme, soliciting a donation Corowa and districts Eisteddfod moved Herbert, secretary, J Roach that 5pounds and two Guineas be donated respectively. Carried.

Frank Galbraith tendering his resignation because of the leaving the district. Moved Herbert secretary. WE that Frank's resignation is accepted and that a letter is sent to him expressing the regret of the members and wishing him every happiness in his new sphere of action. Carried. United Nations charter week, owing to non-arrival of literature it was decided to hold this over till a later date. Leave of absence on the motion of J Roach and WE it is decided to grant leave of absence to John Nelson eight weeks from the date of last attendance. Also to her but three weeks during his vacation.

Food for Britain on the motion of Herbert and ambi it is decided to vote the sum of 5pounds to purchase food parcels for dispatch to the following Rotary clubs for distribution Coventry, London, Bristol, Rutherglen & Chelmsford. Carried.

Nominations for district governor, it was decided that in the event of the Rotary Club of Albury nominating Rotarian Doug Thompson for this position that the Rotary Club of Corowa would support such nominations.

Cashier in absence of official treasurer WE offered to carry out his functions at dinners.

Extension Rotarian WE handed in for the consideration report read the possibility of opening up a club at Yarrawonga. It was decided to send the report and other information to the district governor for his consideration.

Classifications committee members of this where request draw up a list of classifications filled and unfilled for the consideration of the board.

Visitor's badges the question of adopting a better type of badge was referred to the Sergeant of arms for report.

University extension board lecture. At the request of CWA it was decided to invite doctor Hewitt to deliver an address to a joint meeting of members of the Rotary Club and the CWA association about March next. Expenses to be shared on the basis CWA to provide supper and the lecture room.

Rotary Club to meet the extension board fees and pay hotel accommodation.

Lunch meeting it is decided to fix charge for lunch at 3/6 inclusive of 6d for the club.

Recess. It was decided to go into recess over Christmas holidays from the 21st of December to the 11th of January inclusive.

Date of resumption will be the 18th of January. **Confirmed.**

Fri 15th March we had a crew of Rotarian's go to the Ferguson Farm to cook up a storm for the shearers and their families who shore the sheep all proceeded going to the Royal Hospital Appeal.
