Weekly Bulletin CareFlight



This weeks meeting was at the RSL Club and our guest speaker was John Ebbott, the Community Engagement Co-ordinator for CareFlight. John spoke about the excellent work CareFlight does in the community and how the many and varied parts of the organisation help thousands of people each year.

CareFlight is an Australian aeromedical charity, established in 1986 (28 years). Its mission is to save lives, speed recovery and serve the community by providing the highest standard of rapid response critical care. John talked about the use of helicopters, aeroplanes and medi-jets to bring a hospital level of care to the critically ill and injured, especially to children.

CareFlight doctors and nurses are specially trained in pre-hospital and transport medicine. They care for severely injured patients who need emergency treatment at the scene of the incident. They also transport seriously ill patients who need to be moved between hospitals. Currently, CareFlight aeromedical teams care for over 5,000 patients a year. They service the people of New South Wales, the Northern Territory (Top End Retrieval Service) and some international work (International Air Ambulance), mostly with insurance companies. They also undertake, Commercial work, Search and Rescue (over 52.8 million square miles over land and sea) and contribute to many medical publications.

CareFlight has a strong focus on Education, Training and teaching accreditation, with the critical care colleges of anaesthesia, intensive care and emergency medicine. Over the years CareFlight has trained hundreds of critical care specialists in the unique and challenging environment of pre-hospital and transport medicine.

CareFlight is also about innovation. Flying critical care doctors to the seriously ill and injured; introducing night vision goggle technology for safer night flying; conducting a clinical trial to investigate the benefits of early physician intervention for patients with head injuries; these are all Australian 'firsts'.

Everything CareFlight has achieved over the years has been with the support of the community. This loyal and generous support has made it possible for CareFlight to spread their wings across Australia and beyond. They rely on sponsorship, partners, donations, contracts, government assistance, bequests and community individuals to provide the resources and money to make CareFlight happen.




